#### **INTRODUCTION TO SECTION 6 – MISCELLANEOUS**

There is not much to say about this section. It is comprised in part of three chapters from the annals relating to our participation in other yachting organizations. The fourth, and by far the major, part of this section includes the 206 pages related to our trophies. Because of idiosyncrasies in the manner of indexing trophies, searching this part of the archive can be awkward.

Again, the file is "bookmarked" and "searchable". You should find an icon near the upper left corner that resembles a piece of blue ribbon. Clicking on this will display the list of bookmarks and clicking on any of the bookmarks will take you to the relevant page in the file. To search the document, type in an appropriate word in the box near the middle of the top line of the display and then click on the magnifying glass icon. If the word exists in the file, you will be taken to the first instance of it. Using the down arrow, you can move to subsequent instances. Occasionally, information has be inserted on document pages to show the location of pages referred to in the text of the annals. When this is done, reference is made to the PDF page, not the page as numbered in the books. The PDF page is shown as 64/164, for example, in a window on the top line of the display. You can overwrite the leftmost number with another and then jump to that page.

### Other Yachting Organizations

Since world war if the R.V.Y.C. and other northwest clubs in the P.I.Y.A. have broadened their horizons widely, with active affiliation and participation in a number of other organizations.

#### PACIFIC COAST YACHTING ASSOCIATION

This group is made up of regional associations from British Columbia to Southern California, and sponsors the annual Pacific Coast Championship Regatta, which was held at our club in 1950. The late Harold A. Jones was commodore of the association in that year. In the early years of the association, in the 1920's, Capt. James Griffiths of Seattle and Ronald M. Maitland of Vancouver were strong supporters.

#### NORTH AMERICAN YACHT RACING UNION

The N.A.Y.R.U. was the "national" governing body of sailboat racing in both Canada and the U.S.A. for many years until the late 1950's, when both countries joined the International Yacht Racing Union coincident with the adoption of one world wide code of racing rules. The N.A.Y.R.U. sponsors four North American Championships:

Mallory Cup—Senior Men Adams Cup—Senior Ladies

Sears Cup-Juniors

O'Day Cup-Single-handed sailing

Our club members have competed in all of these events, including David Miller, who won the Sears Cup in 1959. The final championship races for this cup were held at the R.V.Y.C. in 1958 and were recognized as an official sports event of the British Columbia Centennial programme.

#### CANADIAN YACHTING ASSOCIATION

The C.Y.A. is responsible for many phases of sailboat racing in Canada, including:

Publication of the official racing rules, and hearing appeals from decisions of local protest committees under these rules.

Sponsoring Olympic and Pan American Games trials, and selecting the representatives from our country for these events, and for raising funds to assist with the cost of taking part.

Sponsoring the annual Junior Championship, which was held at our club in 1964, and assisting with similar events for Sea Scouts, Boy Scouts, university sailing clubs, etc.

Our club members have been active in the organization and racing, Bud Day, Bud Roulstone, Ralph Farris and Frank Hahn having served as Vice Presidents representing B.C., and the following members have represented Canada in the Star Class:

1956 Olympics, Melbourne-E. Pennell and G. Parsons

1959 Pan American Games, Chicago-G. Mason and M. Hunt

1960 Olympics, Naples-W. Burgess, W. West

1964 Olympics, Tokyo-D. Miller and W. West

#### COUNCIL OF B.C. YACHT CLUBS

This group was formed to deal with legislative and other matters involving various levels of government, and has been active in looking after the interests of B.C. yachtsmen in such things as:

Promotion of provincial marine parks at Plumper's Cove, Keats Island, Montague Harbour, and development of launching ramps at many locations.

Protection of pleasure boat anchorages from undue encroachment by log storage and other commercial interests.

Liaison with Ottawa on small vessel safety regulations, equipment standards, etc.

Past Commodore J. M. (Mac) Kerr, Dr. R. E. (Bob) McKechnie and Past Commodore Elmer Palmer are three club members who have taken an active part in the Council activities.

#### INTERNATIONAL POWER BOAT ASSOCIATION

This Association sponsors the annual International Power Boat Race, attracting an entry of 100 to 150 ships, and the Alaska race, held in alternate years.

#### THE VENERABLE BOAT OWNERS' ASSOCIATION

This group within a group was formed about 1957 as a result of an incident at an Easter Cruise in Pender Harbour.

A number of the members' boats, including the *Deirdre*, *Bonaventure II*, the old *Four Bells*, *Hope Point III* and the *Truant* arrived in Pender Harbour together, and as they came around the point, the daughter of a member who owned one of the more glamorous boats exclaimed "Here comes the Turtle Fleet".

It was then decided to form this group within a group whose only requirement was that their vessels must be over a quarter of a century old. There are no rules or regulations or any other such thing—not even DUES!

A pennant was designed as a house flag incorporating a turtle

on a log against a red background. Any members' boats passing the half century mark gets a chevron for his pennant. It might surprise members to know the number of vessels in the club which qualify for this house flag!

"Captain Domo" Doug McPherson, from whom this item was obtained, was unable to state the number of vessels in this "cozy" group; however he recalls that two dozen pennants were ordered and presumably are proudly flown. There are probably quite a few additional yachts in the club that could qualify, and since no dues are involved there is no particular reason why those who are entitled to do so should not acquire an additional "honor" flag to add to their hoist.

### The Council of British Columbia Yacht Clubs

### A BRIEF HISTORY AND REVIEW

In the early years of 1950, a need was recognized by several yacht clubs in B.C. for an organization to represent their interests and the boating public in general in common concerns relating to the use and administration of the coastal waters of B.C. As a result of this recognition, representatives of a few yacht clubs assembled in Nanaimo in 1955 and again in 1956. As a result of these meetings, an association of yacht clubs was formed, and invitations to existing yacht clubs were extended to attend annual meetings. In 1971 a constitution was adopted and the Council of British Columbia Yacht Clubs was born.

The objectives of this Council were to provide liaison between yacht clubs, to advance the common interest of yacht clubs, to monitor legislation and make appropriate recommendations to pertinent levels of government related to legislation and facilities affecting the boating public and yacht clubs, and to cooperate with government agencies in improving boating safety and encourage development and preservation of yachting facilities and marine recreational areas.

In January 1980, the Council was formally incorporated under the Societies Act of B.C., with the same objectives, and became very active in the persuing of these objectives by increasing its membership to over 40 clubs throughout not only the coastal areas, but the interior of B.C. as well, representing over 12,000 yachtmen.

The Council's activities are many and varied. By the use of committees of members it effectively participates in efforts to promote its objectives as seen in the following activities:

An important function of the Council, which is recognized by government, is the referring to Council by the government departments concerned, applications for waterlot leases in coastal areas which may affect the boating public. The Council refers these applications to the appropriate committee and after discussion at general meetings, makes appropriate recommendations to government.

- In other legislative matters, such as the current dispute concerning mining on Gambier Island, the Council has made its member's concerns known in no uncertain terms. Lobbying activities in many other legislative matters affecting yachtsmen are on-going.
- Considerable liaison with the Canadian Coast Guard is carried on regarding safety on the water, and with the Canadian Hydrographic Service regarding charts and aids to navigation.
- 4. Another important activity is the supporting of yacht clubs whose land and waterlot tax assessments by municipal governments fail to recognize the non-profit use of these lands and water leases and the recreation value of these as opposed to commercial ventures.
- 5. The Council promotes the safety of boating via its participation in boat shows, the distribution of "flag a snags", participating in programs sponsored by C.C.G. and many others.
- It participates in organizations whose aim is the reduction of debris and garbage in B.C. waters, and monitors and makes recommendations to appropriate government agencies in this regard.
- In the field of radio-telephone communications it has presented briefs to the C.R.T.C. regarding the fees for and the use of the V.H.F. radio.
- 8. It meets twice annually with the Interclub Association of Washington, a similar group to this Council to discuss mutual problems.

There are many other concerns which arise from time to time, and which are followed up by committees formed for the purpose. Space does not provide for the elaboration of all these activities, but any club belonging to the Council receives much benefit from the Council's activities, besides having opportunities to voice matters which are of particular concern to them in an organization which is gradually receiving more recognition as an effective catalyst in the administration of the use of our boating waters.

As a member of the Council, Royal Van sends delegates to the six or seven meetings each year. Delegates are appointed by the Commodore and serve as the club's representative for yearly periods, and for reasons of continuity terms of serving on Council are often repetitive.

Fees to maintain the Council's activities are assessed each Yacht Club and are proportionate to the particular Club's membership.

# Pacific International Yachting Association

## PACIFIC INTERNATIONAL YACHTING ASSOCIATION by John Dunfield

Formal yacht racing in North America is under the aegis of two governing bodies — the Canadian Yachting Association (CYA) and the United States Yacht Racing Union (U.S.Y.R.U.). All yacht clubs in North America who participate in national or international racing events belong to one or the other, or even both.

To facilitate the overall guidance of racing by U.S.Y.R.U. and C.Y.A., North America is divided into a number of regional groups which, in turn, oversee and regulate racing within their respective regions in conformity with national regulations. The regional authorities pay particular attention to the development of local guidelines to meet specific conditions in their regions.

Pacific International Yachting Association (P.I.Y.A.) is the regional authority for the Pacific Northwest — British Columbia, Washington, Oregon, Idaho — and represents the yacht clubs of the Pacific Northwest on the U.S.Y.R.U. national governing body. Royal Vancouver Yacht Club has been an active participating member of P.I.Y.A. for many years. The club, along with other major yacht clubs in the Northwest, has played a leading role in shaping and developing P.I.Y.A.

P.I.Y.A. composes itself of several sub-committees such as the Safety Committee, Large Boat Committee, Small Boat (One Design) Committee, and Secretaries Committee, etc. The most outstanding contribution P.I.Y.A. has made to regional racing activities is the compilation and publication of the P.I.Y.A. "Safety Regulations". These are without doubt the highest standard in North America (or even in the world). All major races in the Pacific Northwest such as Swiftsure, Southern Straits, Great Equalizer comply with and make mandatory for all yachts the P.I.Y.A. Safety Regulations. Likewise, many yacht clubs for their own local events (particularly overnight races in the Strait of Georgia) adopt specific categories of the Safety Regulations.

P.I.Y.A. organizes the annual regional eliminations for such major national events such as the Mallory Cup, the Sears Cup and the Prince of Wales Cup races. In addition, through the years, P.I.Y.A. has given considerable financial assistance to many young promising sailors in the Pacific Northwest, to enable them to participate in these national championship events.

Royal Vancouver Yacht Club, along with the other member clubs in P.I.Y.A., has assisted in making P.I.Y.A. one of the leading (if not the leading) area racing association in North America and developed a standard of yacht racing for the region that is the equal or even superior to most other regions in North America.

In the past decade, many members of Royal Vancouver Yacht Club have played leading roles in P.I.Y.A. activities; to mention a few — Ken Reid, John Dunfield, Don Martin, Don McLean, John Newton, Tony Liebert and Per Christoffersen.
